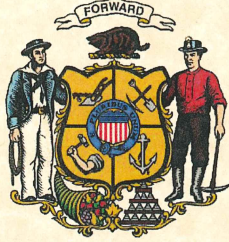

WHEREAS; Radiologic Technology Week is observed each November to highlight and celebrate the important role of radiologic professionals in ensuring the health and well-being of their fellow citizens;
