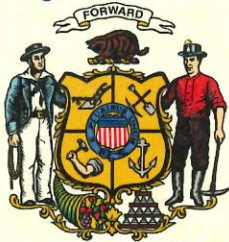

# Proclamation

*WHEREAS*; career development services contribute to Wisconsin's economic prosperity by preparing youth to enter the workforce and by helping workers employed at businesses across our state pursue career advancement opportunities; and

*WHEREAS*; comprehensive career development services are available throughout the state of Wisconsin, including through job centers operated by the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development (DWD) and our state's online labor exchange, JobCenterofWisconsin.com; and

*WHEREAS*; DWD operates numerous workforce training programs—including youth apprenticeships, registered apprenticeships, and numerous programs serving veterans and individuals with disabilities—that provide opportunities for training and employment in high growth industries; and

*WHEREAS*; in partnership with the Wisconsin Department of Corrections, DWD has invested in preparing justice-involved individuals with opportunities to develop their skills in order to enter and succeed in rewarding careers upon their release; and

*WHEREAS*; as part of our state's historic \$130 million investment to address post-pandemic workforce needs, DWD and the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation are implementing three new programs—the Worker Connection Program, the Worker Advancement Initiative, and the Workforce Innovation Grant Program; and

*WHEREAS*; today, the state of Wisconsin joins DWD and partners in promoting career development in our state and celebrating its importance to our state's overall economic recovery and success;


throughout the State of Wisconsin and I commend this observance
