

WHEREAS; from retail and art to restaurants and coffee shops, small businesses are the hearts of communities, acting as catalysts for local economies, supporting the livelihoods of families, creating community spaces and experiences, and bringing unique products and services to every corner of the state; and

WHEREAS; small businesses are powerful drivers of local and statewide economies, and it is estimated that about two-thirds of every dollar spent at a small business stays in the local community, as small businesses are more likely to buy supplies locally, hire locally, and give back to their communities; and

WHEREAS; according to the U.S. Small Business Administration, small businesses employ nearly half of all Wisconsin employees, meaning shopping locally is also an investment in local jobs; and

WHEREAS; a recent analysis of state allocations under the American Rescue Plan Act showed that, as a share of federal aid received by states, Wisconsin is the top state in the country for aid directed to overall economic development and the top state in the country for aid directed to assist businesses in the wake of the coronavirus pandemic; and

WHEREAS; through these investments, Wisconsin has invested millions of dollars to support businesses across the state, including through the We're All In and Wisconsin Tomorrow Small Business Recovery Grants, and Wisconsinites now have more than 7,000 small businesses and nonprofits across all 72 counties to support on Main Streets this holiday season through the Main Street Bounceback Grant Program; and

WHEREAS; on this occasion, the state of Wisconsin joins community leaders, local small businesses and chambers of commerce, and other economic development partners across the state in encouraging all Wisconsinites to celebrate small businesses and the many contributions they make to communities throughout the state each and every day, to explore new small businesses and champion their success, and to show their support for their neighbors and communities by shopping local this holiday season at their favorite small businesses;
