



**EXECUTIVE ORDER #21**

**Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin May Be Flown at Half-Staff in Iowa County as a Mark of Respect for Iowa County District Attorney Larry E. Nelson**

**WHEREAS**, on April 16, 2019, Iowa County District Attorney Larry E. Nelson passed away at the age of 59;

**WHEREAS**, Larry E. Nelson served his community in Iowa County for 33 years, including the last 13 years as District Attorney;

**WHEREAS**, Larry E. Nelson dedicated his life and career to serving his community as a champion for criminal justice and an advocate for victims of crime in Iowa County; and

**WHEREAS**, Larry E. Nelson leaves behind an honorable legacy of service to Iowa County and his state, and the people of Wisconsin mourn his death; and

**WHEREAS**, memorial services will be held in Dodgeville, Wisconsin on April 22 and 23, 2019.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, TONY EVERS**, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by federal and state law, hereby authorize that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin may be flown at half-staff at all public buildings in Iowa County beginning at **sunrise on April 22, 2019, and ending at sunset on April 23, 2019.**
