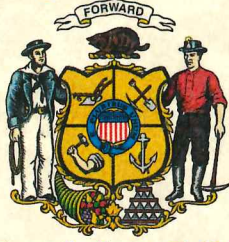

## Proclamation

*WHEREAS*; the enrolled agent profession dates back to 1884 when, after questionable claims had been presented for Civil War losses, Congress acted to regulate persons who represented citizens in their dealings with the U.S. Treasury Department; and

*WHEREAS*; the enrolled agent has been important to both the Wisconsin taxpayers and to the Wisconsin Department of Revenue and is the highest credential awarded by the Internal Revenue Service; and

*WHEREAS*; enrolled agents assist taxpayers with issues from the annual compliance filing of their tax return to more complex issues of audits, liens, levies, appeals, and collections; and

*WHEREAS*; 850 enrolled agents in Wisconsin collectively serve more than a quarter of a million taxpayers every year; and

*WHEREAS*; their knowledge, professionalism, and integrity make the enrolled agent “America's Tax Expert<sup>®</sup>,”

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,
