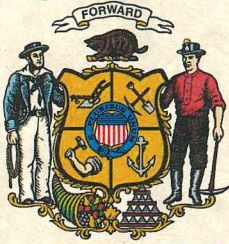

*WHEREAS*, 2-1-1 Wisconsin has managed nearly two million calls since its creation in 2004; and


*WHEREAS*, 2-1-1 Wisconsin has provided critical support and relief to Wisconsin citizens in times of disaster and during emergencies;
