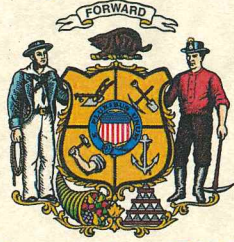


# STATE of WISCONSIN

## Proclamation
