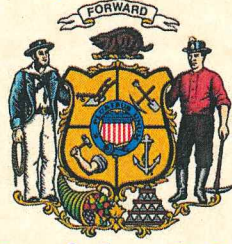


WHEREAS; creating gender balance in honor of International Woman's Day is not exclusive to this one single day, but is a vital goal for all people to strive for and work towards each day;

do hereby proclaim March 8, 2019, as


INTERNATIONAL WOMAN'S DAY
