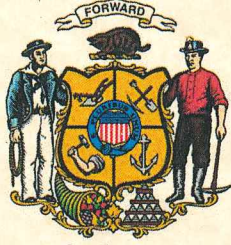



do hereby proclaim March 12, 2019 as


