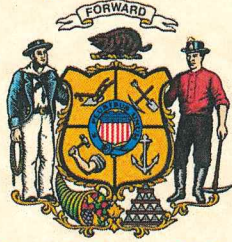

Proclamation

WHEREAS; the number π , sometimes referred to as "pi," represents a mathematical constant, the ratio of a circle's circumference to its diameter; and

WHEREAS; pi is an irrational number that has an infinite number of digits and lacks any consistent recurrence or repetition; and

WHEREAS; pi is, thankfully, often expressed numerically in a much shorter decimal form as 3.14159; and

WHEREAS; mathematic and pie enthusiasts alike celebrate pi on March 14 when the date incidentally coincides with pi's first three digits;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the state of Wisconsin, do hereby proclaim March 14, 2019 as

PI DAY

throughout the state of Wisconsin and I commend this observance to all of our citizens.
