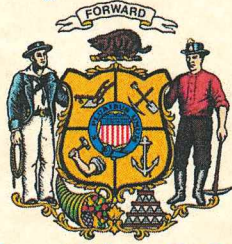


WHEREAS; Wisconsin appreciates professional surveyors and recognizes the important work they do for our communities and our state;
