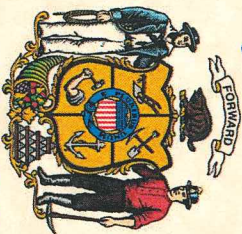

Proclamation

WHEREAS, emergencies can occur at any time and require the prompt response of police, fire, or emergency medical services which are critical to the protection of life and preservation of property; and

WHEREAS, the safety of our police officers, firefighters, and paramedics is dependent upon the quality and accuracy of information obtained from citizens who contact communications centers; and

WHEREAS, public safety telecommunicators are the first and most critical contact our citizens have with emergency services; and

WHEREAS, public safety telecommunicators are the single vital link for our police officers, firefighters, paramedics by monitoring their activities by radio, providing them information and ensuring their safety; and

WHEREAS, public safety telecommunicators in the state of Wisconsin have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires, and treatment of patients through their commitment and dedication to public safety; and

WHEREAS, each public safety telecommunicator exhibits compassion, understanding, and professionalism during the performance of their duties;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the state of Wisconsin,
do hereby proclaim April 14-20, 2019 as

throughout the state of Wisconsin, and I commend this observance to all of our citizens.
