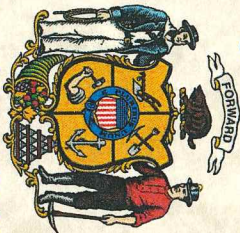

WHEREAS, the people of the State of Wisconsin should recognize the important service performed by records and information professionals;

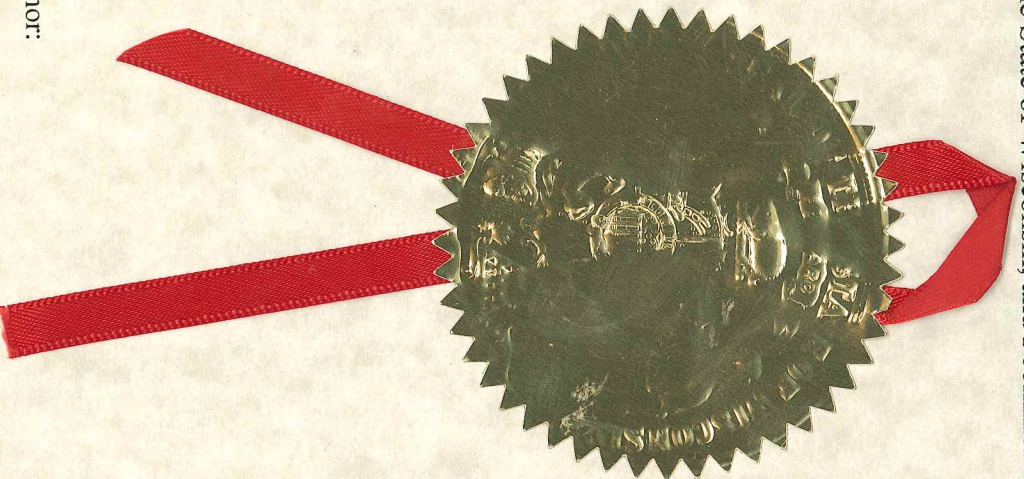
NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby proclaim April 2019, as
