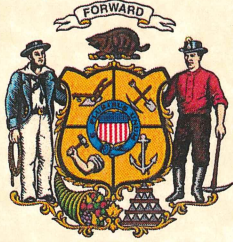

Proclamation

WHEREAS; The Energy Fair is the nation's longest-running event of its kind and brings over 10,000 attendees together each year to learn about sustainability and clean energy, connect with others, and take action toward a sustainable future; and

WHEREAS; 2019 marks the 30th Anniversary of The Energy Fair; and

WHEREAS; individuals from Wisconsin and across the United States come to The Energy Fair to hear inspirational keynote speakers and learn about renewable energy careers, clean transportation, green building, energy efficiency, sustainable farms and gardens, wind and solar, and environmental justice;
