
STATE of WISCONSIN

WHEREAS; many pregnant women and new mothers who want to breastfeed often face barriers in community, health care, and employment settings, including racial and ethnic discrimination; and

WHEREAS; Wisconsin supports the Surgeon General's "Call to Action to Support Breastfeeding," which emphasizes the importance of breastfeeding as a public health imperative and a proven primary prevention strategy; and

WHEREAS; the Department of Health Services, local health departments, and tribal organizations promote and support exclusive breastfeeding as the optimal method of infant feeding through the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children and other nutrition programs; and


WHEREAS; 2019 marks nine years since the passage of Assembly Bill 57, codifying a mother's right to breastfeed her child in any location in Wisconsin where the mother and child are otherwise authorized to be; and

WHEREAS; health and breastfeeding advocates worldwide join in celebrating and promoting awareness of the benefits of breastfeeding by building individual, family, and community support for breastfeeding, supporting strategies that protect optimal breastfeeding practices, and fostering systems and environments that help to increase breastfeeding rates for all families and communities;
