WHEREAS; people cause more than 98% of all wildfires in Wisconsin, but understanding what commonly causes fires and taking preventative action can greatly decrease your chances of causing or contributing to a wildfire; and

WHEREAS; Smokey's iconic message – "Only You Can Prevent Wildfires" – continues to play an important role in protecting the 17.1 million acres of forests in Wisconsin today; and

WHEREAS; Smokey has contributed significantly to public education, health, and safety for the past 75 years, and he has many more years of service ahead of him;
