

WHEREAS; the "Year of Return" is designed to celebrate the collective resilience of the African community upon the 400th year of their ancestors' enslavement and displacement throughout the Americas, the Caribbean, Europe, and Asia; and

WHEREAS; the "Year of Return" provides an opportunity for all Americans to reflect on the atrocities of our past, the progress we have made, and the fight for equity, freedom, and justice still to be had; and

WHEREAS; Ghana's successful fight for independence from Great Britain in 1957 served as a beacon of hope for civil rights leaders during the American Civil Rights movement, inspiring activists like Martin Luther King Jr. and Coretta Scott King; and

WHEREAS; the struggle for equity, freedom, and justice for all peoples of the African diaspora are woven together through collective origin, struggle, pain, and pride;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby proclaim August 18 – 25, 2019, as the
